On a Jewish Vilnius Walking Tour, our guides offer you a deep dive into Vilnius Jewish history, a story of prosperous Jewish life, and its sudden and devastating demise. The city, known as Jerusalem of Lithuania, had one of the largest Jewish populations (over 45% Jewish) in all of eastern Europe. It had 105 synagogues, [six daily Jewish newspapers](#), and the language of choice was Yiddish.

Today the Jewish community is once again vibrant and secure. Heritage trips and community events are frequent and help educate the new generation about their past and preserve Jewish culture. People from all over the world, even from the United States, come to pay respects to Vilnius Jewish cemetery.
